Decision No. KRC-2017 / Proc-152 / Pa. pu. 16 Date: 20/12/2019 for Maharashtra three times According to the selection of the organization, the organization has surveyed a total of 240 villages in Raigad, Nashik, Dhule, Satara, Palghar, Yavatmal talukas and submitted the report to the concerned Zilla Parishad and Maharashtra Government Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Belapur, Mumbai. . While inspecting the village, the organization had selected the staff for the inspection. The inspection was carried out by dividing the village into different parts. It mainly inspected individual toilets, public toilets, village utensils, Hagandari-free former premises and every government school in school cleanliness. Visited private schools, Angan Wadi, colleges and inspected the health and hygiene of the students as well as the personal hygiene of the students. The sanitary house here is technically correct or how and solid waste. Village Sarpanch, teachers, Anganwadi workers, village members and villagers Guidance was given by discussing with the distinguished citizens, and also about the health of the teenage girl, whether the sanitary napkins are used or not. All the government offices and private offices in the village were inspected.

While conducting the investigation, the organization guided the villagers about health and hygiene. It is found that the children in the village have become aware about health and hygiene.

To provide information about village free concept and sustainability of Hagandari free village, information about the problems that occur while making Hagandari free village and becoming Hagandari free village and the solution to the problem of improved sanitation, importance of respiratory hygiene and its relation to healthy nutrition. Giving, making them aware of their role and responsibilities, training the trainees to work at the village level, skills change, community organization, etc. To develop reporting skills and capacity, to provide information on government plans / policies, institutional structure information, to provide guidance on maintaining cleanliness at all institutional levels at Gram Panchayat level.

Jalgaon Zilla Parishad selected the organization for making ODEP plan in Jalgaon district. In this project, the organization completed the work of preparing village plan of total villages in Bodwad, Yaval, Pachora, Chalisgaon talukas. A three day process was implemented in each village in this taluka. On the first day, the first torch relay was held and then ward meetings were held in each ward to inform the villagers about the ODEP plan and to discuss the health and hygiene activities in their area. On the second day, village sarpanchs, village members, anganwadi workers, helpers, volunteers and government employees were given guidance on the scheme and a discussion was held on what can be done in the field of health and hygiene in our village. The villagers were further read out about who can take up the work in the plan in their village and it was approved by the Gram Sabha. The same plan was submitted to the Zilla Parishad with the approval of the Gram Sabha.

Zilla Parishad Jalgaon selected as a supporting organization for this project on 27/1/2006. The first organization implemented Jalaswaraj project in 19 villages of Jalgaon district. The objective of the supporting organization in this project is to improve water supply and sanitation. For example, to assist in capacity building, awareness programs, monitoring in all phases of planning, implementation, and maintenance repair. It is about empowering and cooperating as needed. In this, water supply committee members, sarpanch, village members, anganwadi workers, helpers, village self help groups were given training on health and hygiene. Technical guidance was also imparted. Also, ward meetings, gram sabhas were conducted to guide the villagers on health and hygiene. A detailed project report was read in the Gram Sabha and the work was carried out accordingly. Due to this project, the villagers became aware of the cleanliness of the village and today every citizen of the village is emphasizing on health and hygiene. 100% of the villagers are using toilets. .

Also Zilla Parishad Jalgaon re-selected for Jal Swaraj project on 05/04/2018. At this time training was given in one village each in Raver, Pachora, Bhusawal, Jalgaon talukas. A total of 160 trainees were present for this training.

Awareness: - The organization is implementing various schemes of the government and while implementing the scheme, in order to create awareness among the villagers, the organization reaches out to the villagers through the street play of the project.
